Our 3-6 Glee Club has been invited to participate in the Combined Choir as part of the Penrith Valley Performing Arts Festival. This is a great opportunity for our students to gain confidence in performance, work with other musical groups in a professional performance space and showcase to their family and friends what they have been working towards this year. The specific performance date, which will be an evening performance, will be announced shortly but the festival will run from **August 8 - 11**. Tickets are available from July 22.

To participate in the festival, students from the Glee Club will need to commit to Monday Recess Rehearsals as well as combined rehearsals at Jamisontown Public School (**June 16, 2022**) and the Joan Sutherland Performing Arts Centre (Date TBC). It is asked that parents that are able, transport their children to and from these rehearsals. If you are unable to, students will travel by car, driven by our teaching staff or school community members.

Students will also be required to wear the Penrith Valley Performing Arts Festival T-Shirt, black pants or skirt, black socks or black opaque stockings and plain, black shoes for both dress rehearsal and performance night.

To ensure all students from Glee Club have this opportunity, we ask that you please return the attached notes by **May 16, 2022**, committing and giving permission for your child to be part of the festival.

We are so excited to be involved with the Combined Choir and look forward to performing at the festival in Term 3.
