

Student Voice - 3/4 Class Report




Writing this is my final act as School Vice-Captain of Luddenham PS. I have enjoyed my position as I have been able to run assemblies and it has been an honour.


Thank you to all of the staff, students and parents for another excellent term at Luddenham Public School.
